

GRADING SYSTEM

Students are to be awarded grades according to the following scheme :

SCHOLASTIC - A

Grades are awarded on a 8-point grading scale as follows

1. Scholastic Areas:

TERM-I EXAM - 20 Marks

Term wise on a 3-point grading scale
(A=Outstanding, B=Very Good,

FOR PAENTS TO NOTE

1. Overall performance is to be decided on the basis of achievement in the Scholastic as well as in the co-scholastic areas.
2. Minimum qualifying gade is D in all the five subjects in scholastic domain 1A.
3. The qualifying grade in 1B section of scholastic domain is B.
4. If the grade point range is 53-65, student gets the benifit of up scaling of grade to next higher grade in two subject.
5. If the grade point range is 40-52, student gets the benifit of up scaling of grade to next higher grade in one subject.
6. A series or star beside the grade reflects up scaled grade.

For The Parents

1. The progress Report Card aims at keeping the parents informed the progress of their child in the school throughout the year.

Parents are requested to inspect it carefully and sign it towards acknowledgement.

2. Annual promotion of student to a higher class depends on the child's performance throughout the year not merely on mark scored in the final examination. In which 40% Marks in overall subjects is mandatory.

3. The Report Card will not be issued if fees are in arrears.

4. Child must preserve this card as it contains valuable information.

5. Class attendance of 75% is essential condition for promotion. No exemption shall be allowed on any grounds.

6. In case of loss, fine of Rs. 500/- will have to be paid for issue of another new card.

7. Parents/guardians must sign, this report and return it to the class teacher within three days of the date of issue. Which shows your inspection towards your child.
